Those selected will be awarded this scholarship only after completion of two semesters of coursework and completion of the criteria listed below. Scholarship funds are intended to assist Vinita High School graduates who are pursuing a post-secondary degree or certification. Financial assistance will be awarded at the conclusion of each school year. The amount of this year's scholarships will be a minimum of 500.00.

Awarded to: Vinita High School graduates and is **not** exclusive to only current graduates. All Vinita High School graduates are eligible to apply.

Selection Criteria:

- College grade point average of 2.5 or better required
- First priority will be given to those who have completed 12 hours of college credit in the previous semester and are enrolled in 12 hours currently
- ACT Score will be provided by Vinita High School
- Civic, community and college activities
- Essay outlining course of study and future goals
- Application must be received in the High School Principal's office by noon on June 12, 2018

Selection Procedure:

- Student must make application, including essay
- Committee made up of high school principal or designee and high school counselors or designee and Superintendent or designee
